

## JOIN THE CELEBRATION

Once again it's that time of year to start planning and finalizing **The Harvest Moon Festival**. After a very successful year we are looking forward to an even greater response for booth rental.

This year the **16<sup>th</sup> Annual Harvest Moon Festival** will be held October 3 & 4, 2009, at the Biddle Memorial Park located at the intersection of St. Rd. 47 and 38.

Enclosed is an application for booth space. Each booth is 10 feet x 10 feet in size. There will be designated areas for food booths and craft booths.

**Food Booth** rental. See Attached. All food/beverage vendors will be required to provide proof of liability insurance.

**Non-food booth** rental is \$50 per 10X10 booth space for the two days.

**\$10.00 extra for electricity: this is an option for all booth holders per availability.**

Booths must be set up between 4pm-7pm Friday or 6am-8am on Saturday.

ALL BOOTHS MUST REMAIN OPEN BOTH DAYS. All booths must be open from 9am-6pm on Saturday and 11am-4pm on Sunday. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Deadline for applications is September 18, 2009. A letter of confirmation will be sent upon receipt of application and payment. **(NON-REFUNDABLE)**

Food Vendors that sell for profit will be required to obtain a temporary license from Hamilton County Health Department. If you need an application for a temporary license or if you have questions pertaining to this you may contact the health department at 317-776-8500. Someone from the health department will be on site Saturday to make sure those who must be licensed are, and look over booths. It is advisable all food preparers wear hair nets.

There will be no raffle permitted in the food area. Also, no items will be sold with alcohol, tobacco or profane language on them. Guns, Edged Weapons, Blow Guns, or Silly String are not permitted to be sold.
